### **Directions to the Event Grounds**

From Route 2 – Take the Athol exit onto Route 2A. Proceed to Route 32. Take Route 32 north approximately 7 miles. Route 32 merges with Route 68 just north of the main entrance to Hedgerow Kennel and Hunt Club. The entrance to the event grounds is from Route 68. Take Route 68 east approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile. The entrance is on the right.

From Keene, NH – Take Route 12 south and turn right onto Route 32. Continue on Route 32 into MA. Turn left on Route 68. The entrance to the event grounds is from Route 68. Take Route 68 east approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile. The entrance is on the right.
