HOW TO USE THIS EVALUATION FORM:

- The 5 abilities of a dog are graded on a scale of 0-10 in each applicable test component. In order for a dog qualify, it must not have received a score less than 5 in any "cell" of the scoring matrix. In addition, it must average no less than 5.0 for each ability and receive an overall average of no less than 7.0 across all abilities.
- The following traits constitute grounds for scoring the indicated ability as "0":
 - Failure to find birds (Bird Finding Ability).
 - Blinking (Bird Finding Ability).
 - Refusal to flush (Flushing Ability).
 - Viciousness, gun-shyness, out of control (Trained Abilities).
 - Hard-mouth, refused retrieve (Retrieving Abilities).
 - Recast in hunt dead or water blind.
